INDIVIDUAL REGULATIONS (IREX)

1. Organizer, date and location

- 1.1 The MULTILATERAL Stamp Exhibition is organised by the Landesverband Südwestdeutscher Briefmarkensammlervereine e.V. as a National Competition Exhibition in accordance with the Exhibition Regulations (AO), the Implementation Regulations (DB) and the Evaluation Regulations (BR) of the BDPH valid at the time of registration.

It will take place from 28 to 30 October 2027 in the exhibition halls in 89073 Ulm, Böfinger Str. 50. All exhibition classes are admitted.

2. Exhibitors

- 2.1 All exhibitors who are members or direct members of an association of multilateral associations can participate as exhibitors in the competition.
- 2.2 The prerequisite for participation in the exhibition is timely registration, acceptance of the exhibit by the Philatelic Committee and timely payment of the framework fees.

- Experimental Class "1–3 Frames"

The exhibitors of the Experimental Class do not have to comply with the regulations for the competition classes. There is no evaluation of these exhibits. The youth exhibits and single-frame exhibits will be integrated into the corresponding classes.

4. Exhibition Frame

- 4.1 Each frame can accommodate 16 exhibition sheets in DIN A4 format or commercially available album sheet formats. Other formats such as square sheet formats or DIN A3 sheets are permitted.
- 4.2 If sheet formats deviate, for example in the sheet width, it must be ensured that the frame area is completely filled even if there is a smaller number of sheets per frame.

5. Registration, selection, exhibition obligation

- 5.1 The registration of the exhibits to be exhibited by the Multilateral Associations must be made by 1 July 2027 via the respective National Commissioner. The registration of the exhibits of the German exhibitors must be received by **July 1, 2027**, with the event director of the MULTILATERALE Bernward Schubert, Uferstr.22, 71642 Ludwigsburg. Registrations are only possible on the forms of the organizer. With the registration, a short description of the exhibit, the structure and, if possible, a synopsis must be submitted.
- 5.2 The Philatelic Committee decides on its acceptance. With the confirmation of acceptance, the exhibitor receives notification of the allocated number of frames. If the exhibit is rejected, the reasons will be given.
- 5.3 By accepting the exhibit, the exhibitor irrevocably undertakes to participate in the exhibition with it.

6. Exhibition fees and awards

- 6.1 The exhibition fees are 50.00 euros per frame (one frame = 16 sheets DIN A4). For single-frame exhibits, 60.00 euros per exhibit are due. For single-frame exhibits up to 3 frames, 50.00 euros are charged per frame.
- 6.2 Participation in Youth Philately is free of charge.
- 6.3 The exhibition fees for a literature exhibit are 30.00 euros.
- 6.4 The framework fees must be paid into the account designated by the National Commissioner no later than 14 days after receipt of the confirmation of acceptance. The National commissioners must transfer the framework fees to the account of the Landesverband Südwest by August 1, 2027 at the latest.
- 6.5 Diplomas and commemorative medals will be awarded. In addition, honorary prizes are made available to the jury.

7. Security and insurance

- 7.1 Event manager and organizers as well as their representatives are concerned with the greatest possible care in the handling of the exhibits as well as the greatest possible safety in the exhibition rooms. Liability for damage, loss or other losses is not assumed.
- 7.2 Each exhibitor is recommended to take out their own exhibit insurance.

8. Construction and dismantling of the exhibits

- 8.1 If possible, the exhibits should be set up by the exhibitor or an authorised representative on 27 October 2027 between 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. It is not possible to deposit parts of the collection.
- 8.2 If it is not possible for the exhibitor or his authorised representative to set it up, the exhibit must be sent to the exhibition manager at the exhibitor's expense by 18 October 2027 at the latest.

- 8.3 The exhibit intended for assembly by the event management must be accompanied by a table of contents when it is sent, showing the number of sheets and the number of stamps, letters, etc. per sheet.
- 8.4 Each sheet must be individually numbered, mounted on a stable surface and housed in a transparent sleeve.
- 8.5 In addition, exhibitors will be offered the opportunity to conduct a preliminary talk with jurors. With the registration confirmation, you will receive the schedule agreed with the organizer and the jurors, which must be adhered.
- 8.6 The dismantling will take place on 30 October 2027 after the exhibition closes and according to a schedule agreed with the exhibitor.
- 8.7 Exhibits that cannot be dismantled by the exhibitor or a representative with a written authorisation will be dismantled by the event management after the exhibition has closed, packed and returned to the exhibitor's address at the exhibitor's expense. For this purpose, suitable packaging material and prepared address (parcel) stickers must be attached to the exhibit.

9. Evaluation of the exhibits

- 9.1 The exhibits will be judged by a jury according to the provisions of the current exhibition regulations of the BDPH.
- 9.2 The jury can consult expert advisors from the BDPH working groups or specialists known to it.

10. Rights of the Event Management

- 10.1 The event management has the right to reject exhibits registered or already sent in whole or in part, if necessary after consultation with the Philatelic Committee, or to bring them to the exhibition in a manner other than the type of registration. Exhibition fees already paid will only be refunded if the exhibit is completely rejected.
- 10.2 For exhibits not sent in time, the exhibition fee must be paid in any case.
- 10.3 In all other cases not provided for in the exhibition regulations of the BDPH, the event management decides.
- 10.4 The decision of the Philatelic Committee, the jury and the event management are final and incontestable.

11. General Provisions

- 11.1 By signing the registration form, the exhibitor expressly acknowledges the exhibition regulations of the BDPH and the special conditions of the MULTILATERAL Competition Exhibition.
